

Vaccine appointments for seniors COVID-19

Seniors 80 years and older (Indigenous Seniors 65 years and older) can schedule their vaccination at anytime after registration opens for their age group, by year of birth. You will be able to book for yourself or on behalf of someone else.

Once you are eligible to receive a vaccine, you are always eligible. You won't miss your chance to be vaccinated.

COVID-19 IN BC

Have the following information on hand when you call: Full name, date of birth, postal code, Personal Health Number, email address or a mobile phone number (for text messages). You may also provide a family member or friend's phone number or email if you do not have one.

Scam Alert: You will NOT be asked for your SIN, driver's license number, banking or credit card details. If someone calls you claiming to be from the health authority and asks for these details, hang up immediately.

You can find your Personal Health Number on the back of your B.C. driver's license, BC Services Card or CareCard. If you do not have a Personal Health Number, you can still receive the vaccine.
